2019 OLD VINES CABERNET SAUVIGNON

The 2019 Hollick Cabernet Sauvignon *ov* is made from a selection of fruit from our older Cabernet Sauvignon vines (OV). It is grown on shallow terra rossa soils in the Neilson's Block and Wilgha vineyards in Coonawarra, planted in the 1970s and 1980s.

The 2019 vintage can be characterised by warm sunny days and cool nights providing the perfect, even ripening conditions for our famed Coonawarra Cabernet.

Our Cabernet Sauvignon was picked gradually at optimum ripeness from late March to late April. Exceptional colour intensity and vibrant fruit character are the hallmarks of this vintage.

In the winery, individual parcels of grapes were handled carefully to retain intense fruit flavours developed in the vineyard. Subsequent maturation in French oak (20% new) provides the 2019 Cabernet Sauvignon with structure and presence on the palate.
