Tulloch has six distinct ranges of wines, including our much-loved Tulloch Range lead by the Tulloch Verdelho, as well as our Vineyard Selection, Limited Release, Heritage, G Series and Cellar Door Only ranges completing the portfolio.

### Pokolbin Dry Red Shiraz

The Heritage range of wines is a toast to our company's history and the great wines of the past. The Pokolbin Dry Red label was first used in 1952 and became one of the premium red wines of Australia. With this range we continue the history and celebrate the heritage of Tulloch.
