**James Suckling - October 2022 - 90 Points**

"This has a crisp acidity, but is dense and tannic to the point of being slightly inky. Plenty of plum with notes of smoke, bark and hibiscus. Drink now. Screw cap."

"The Angove Warboys vineyard is planted roadside and around the cellar door on Chalk Hill Rd in McLaren Vale. The Grenache vines number just six rows, so the fruit is split between this and the Grenache cuvee. The nose of the 2019 Warboys Vineyard Shiraz Grenache is plush and cushioned, with notes of cocoa-dusted raspberries, licorice, pink peppercorns and star anise ... it's incredibly aromatic. The injection of Shiraz in this blend (as compared to the varietal Grenache bottling) contributes a real generosity and plumpness to the overall. This is fleshy and pleasurable, with rivulets of saline acidity that course through the mid-palate and finish. Very nice."

"A deep ruby-red colour. Blueberry, anise and dark chocolate aromas. A full-bodied red that fills the senses with dark fruits and Christmas cake spices. Textured and velvety in its flow to a very long finish, carried by very supple tannins and a hint of freshening acidity."
