The Tulloch story began in 1895 when John Younie Tulloch accepted an unusual settlement of a debt – a 43-acre property at Pokolbin in the Hunter Valley containing 5 acres of neglected Shiraz vines. Today, the Tulloch name lives on as a founding wine producer of the region with a renewed commitment to the production of premium Hunter Valley varietals and wine styles for all generations. Tulloch has six distinct ranges of wines, including our much-loved Tulloch Range lead by the Tulloch Verdelho, as well as our Vineyard Selection, Limited Release, Heritage, G Series and Cellar Door Only ranges completing the portfolio.

### Private Bin Pokolbin Dry Red Shiraz

The Heritage range of wines is a toast to our company's history and the great wines of the past. The Pokolbin Dry Red label was first used in 1952 and became one of the premium red wines of Australia. With this range we continue the history and celebrate the heritage of Tulloch. The 2017 Release commemorates The Founder, John Younie Tulloch who navigated Tulloch Wines to success in the early 1900's and inaugurated the family tradition that continues today.
